



SYDNEY

Cosmopolitan Sydney, with its beautiful port and a relaxed life-style, is one of the most beautiful cities in the world.

Sydney is the largest Australian city, the nation's economic powerhouse and Australia's capital city in everything but the name. This city vibrates with energy and offers everything someone could ask for from a destination: the most beautiful port in the world crossed by an equally amazing bridge (known as The Coathanger), the famous Opera House, a pleasant climate, godly beaches for surf, a multitude of restaurants and bars that vibrate with nightlife.

Sydney is blessed with a soft climate, the temperature rarely falls under 10 degrees C over night, with an average of 25C in the summer and over 300 sunny days a year. The winters are rather cool then cold.



MELBOURNE

Despite the fact that it's Continental Australia's smallest state (aprox. the size of Great Britain), Victoria has a lot to offer. It's a place of contrasts, beaches and mountains, desert and forests, volcanic fields and huge farms.

The city of Melbourne, Victoria's capital city, has been inhabited ever since 1830 by Europeans. Melbourne produces one of the most innovative arts, music, food, fashion, shows, design and culture in Australia. Gold Coast is a unique city, and one of the best places in the world for holiday and studies.



Education system



Study options

An Australian qualification can have a significant impact on your life, adding new skills and knowledge that can boost your career or give you a new direction in life. In a competitive job market, it is time to obtain an advantage that a course in Australia can offer.

› ENGLISH ‹

If your level of English needs to be improved before starting a course or you want to study English language for different reasons, an English language course in a native speaking country like Australia can help.

Australia offers a variety of specialised English courses. You can study these courses in any of Australia's largest cities or in a quieter, more exotic places: Noosa, Gold Coast, Sunshine Coast, Byron Bay, etc...

› VET ‹

A relevant characteristic of the VET (Vocational Education and Training) courses is, they tend to focus more on developing practical skills in a certain occupation, while the Higher Education courses focus more on theory and professional development.

VET courses are different from the Higher Education because they are practical courses, with a shorter duration and a lower cost and offer a lower qualification than Higher Education courses (Bachelor degrees, Master degrees, etc...).

› HIGHER EDUCATION ‹

Undergraduate courses are based in essence on theory and represent the first professional qualification at an academic level. The typical course that falls under this category is the Bachelor degree with a duration of 3 or 4 years depending on the major. It can also last for 2 years if the fast-track option is used.

The typical courses that fall under the Postgraduate category are the Postgraduate courses.

› RESEARCH ‹

Courses that fall in this category are the Master or PhD courses that have at least a third of the studies based on research and no more than one third of theory.

The typical courses for this category are the Master (by Research) – different from the Mast (by Coursework) – and the PhD or doctorate courses.

International students that study these courses and their dependents will receive full work rights for the duration of their stay in Australia.

Regardless of you wanting to get a job on the job market or you want to make a first step towards university, a vocational qualification in Australia can lead you where you want to get.

The Australia vocational sector (or VET) is based on an industry and government partnership. Education institutions called Technical and Further Education (TAFE) or private education institutions called RTO – Registered Training Organization, offer VET qualifications in Australia.

Many VET courses offer on-site training, which means you, won't learn only in the classroom but obtain precious work experience in a real workplace.

In Australia, the quality of education is guaranteed. As a matter of fact, international student's safety and experience is protected by law through ESOS – Education Services for Overseas Students Act adopted in the year 2000.

DIPLOMA OF NURSING (ENROLLED/DIVISION 2 NURSING)

This study program has been created by the nursing industry to prepare individuals interested in the Enrolled Nurse (different from the Registered Nurse) profession and for professional development for those already employed in the industry. Enrolled Nurse are individuals who practice nursing under the supervision of a Registered Nurse.

This course is usually, the first step in a Registered Nurse career. The course duration varies from 1 year to 1.5 years.

If you've recently graduated from High school, you are probably thinking to enhance your qualification at an undergraduate level.

The Undergraduate studies in Australia commonly refer to the Bachelor degree courses. Undergraduate courses are for those of us who have never graduated from university.

The entry requirements for a Bachelor degree in general, are Year 12 Graduation Certificate plus an IELTS Academic with a score of 6.0 or equivalent, depending on the field of study. The English tests accepted by a university are IELTS Academic, TOEFL iBT, Cambridge ESOL and Pearson PTE.

The typical duration of a Bachelor degree is 3 years. You can also fast-track your degree and graduating in 2 years.

BACHELOR OF ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY (TELECOMMUNICATIONS)

This course's purpose is to help students develop and demonstrate an understanding of the fundamental principles of telecommunications engineering. Students develop skills in industry relevant technologies and independent study, efficient communication, time management and teamwork. The course offers both theoretical knowledge and applied knowledge in engineering, telecommunications and networking.

Entry requirements

- Year 12;
- IELTS Academic 6.0 (no band under 5.5) or equivalent;

Career opportunities

Graduates of this course can find work in leadership positions in the field of telecommunications, network management, telecommunications services in a variety of companies both public and private.

BACHELOR OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (BUSINESS SYSTEMS)

This course focuses on the organizational technological issues necessary to analyze and design a company's information systems. The program takes into consideration principles and modern theories together with practical applications of technology.

The course duration is 3 years.

Entry requirements

- Year 12;
- IELTS Academic 6.0 (no band under 5.5) or equivalent;

BACHELOR OF BUSINESS (HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT)

Postgraduate courses in Australia refer, in general, to programs students can study if they have extensive work experience or they graduated with a degree. The postgraduate programs vary from Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma, to Master (by Coursework), programs that have less than 33% of course structure based on research.

The minimum entry requirements for a postgraduate course are a minimum of a bachelor degree and an IELTS Academic score of 6.5 or equivalent. The English language tests accepted by the universities, besides IELTS Academic are TOEFL iBT, Cambridge ESOL, Pearson PTE.

The common duration of a Master degree is 1.5 years of 2 years. It is recommended international students take up a program that it's at least 2 years in duration to be able to meet the requirements for a PostStudy Work Visa after graduation.

MASTER OF ARCHITECTURE

This program equips students with theoretical knowledge of history, design, technical knowledge and skills, a practical understanding, research skills and personal and professional values that together with the practical experience will prepare students to enter the profession of Architect.

Course duration is 2 years.

Entry requirements

- A Bachelor degree in the field of Architecture;
- IELTS Academic 7.0 (no band under 6.5) or equivalent;

Career opportunities

Graduates will be able to apply for jobs in a variety of organizations specialized in the field of Architecture, private companies or local administration.

MASTER OF INFORMATION SYSTEMS

This program offers you the opportunity to extend your knowledge and skills in the field of Information Systems, as an integral part to improve an organization's performance. You will build on already acquired knowledges of design, implementation and management problems that come up in the implementation of information technology processes.

Course duration is 2 years.

Entry requirements

- Bachelor degree;
- IELTS Academic 6.5 (no band under 6.0) or equivalent;

A Master (by Research) qualification is granted by a university to a student who brought an original contribution to a field of study in a 2 years full-time study. Usually, a no more than 50 000 words thesis will be required to show the research findings.

The qualification of Doctor is granted following a substantial contribution to a field of study in a 2 or 4 years of full-time research.

In both cases, Master (by Research) or PhD, the programs include certain theoretical parts, but the main activity is focused on Research.

Master of Engineering (by Research)

Develop your knowledge and focus your practical skills on a specific research area in engineering. You will undertake research on a topic that you and your supervisor choose.

- Mechanical Engineering
- Transportation
- Physics

Entry Requirements

A Bachelor degree of minimum 4 years study in a field such as Engineering, Building Surveying, Computer Science, Physics or Chemistry; IELTS (Academic) with a minim score of 6.5 no band under 6.0;

Career opportunities

After graduation you will be able to choose to further study towards a PhD or you can opt in to become a research assistant or a research technician.



Master of Architecture (by Research)

This course allows individual research in the field of Architecture. The course can be graduated in 2 years of full-time study and fits well with students who are looking to further and deepen their knowledge in a certain field of study through an academic supervised research.

Students will develop skills in critical thinking, analysis and research methods under academic, internationally accredited supervision while producing a thesis of minimum 60 000 – 80 000 words.

Entry requirements

Minimum a bachelor degree with good grades in the field of study.

Career opportunities

Graduates are eligible to register as Architects with Architects Registration Board of Australia.

International students need to meet all admission requirements and English language requirements to be able to enrol in a course in Australia.


Entry requirements vary depending on the program, academic performance and in some cases, on relevant work experience. You will have to show proof of your qualification from a recognized education institution. Below you can find the steps you need to take in order to enrol in a course in Australia.

WHEN TO APPLY?

Course start dates vary. In general, the university courses start in February and July. Some courses start in November. We encourage you to send us your application as soon as possible. Research program's applications are accepted across the year.



ACCOMMODATION

There are a variety of accommodation options for international students in Australia, from university campus accommodation to apartment rental or shared accommodation, where students from different countries and cultures share the accommodation and split their living expenses.

Finding the perfect accommodation is one of the biggest challenges for an international student and finding one to fit your budget is even bigger.

It's a good idea to find a temporary accommodation before arriving in Australia. This will offer you enough time to know places and search for a more permanent accommodation.

The college or university can help you or you can book your accommodation on www.yha.com or www.hostels.com. Another great website is www.booking.com. For last minute bookings or short term accommodation, you can use www.getaroom.com.au or www.wotif.com but hotels in Australia's larger cities are expensive charging a minimum of AUD\$150 per night.

Australia offers a variety of accommodation options for students at a high standard and different budgets. Campus rooms, hostels, Homestays, shared accommodation, all these are popular.

Studying at university level involves certain costs including living costs and tuition fees. Some of them are fixed and others will vary, depending on the program you choose and your lifestyle.

Tuition fees

Tuition fees vary from one program to another. On top of the tuition fees, students have to budget for the following:

Overseas Student Health Cover – OSHC

Students will need to organize the health insurance before arriving in Australia and before applying for their student visa. The health insurance will need to be paid in advance for the entire period of study. HELLO AUSSIE STUDENT SERVICES can assist you with this step. OSHC is currently around AUD\$380 per year for a single cover. If you bring your spouse as a dependent on your student visa, you will have to get a couple cover and if you bring your kids as well, you will have to pay for a Family cover.

Materials cost

Students will have to budget for the cost of books and study materials. These will cost around AUD\$400 per year.

Australian student visa


It is essential to apply for a student visa before arriving in Australia. For detailed information on how to apply for a student visa, contact the Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP), browse DIBP official website or ask your educational consultant (HELLO AUSSIE STUDENT SERVICES).

YOUR WORK RIGHTS ON STUDENT VISA

A person on a student visa can work in Australia up to 40 hours per every 2 weeks during their studies and full-time in holidays. Every university has a specialized department who offers free job search services to their students. If your spouse travels with you to Australia as a dependent, he will have the right to work full-time if you study a Master degree and part-time in all other cases.

YOUR FAMILY CAN TRAVEL WITH YOU TO AUSTRALIA

Your spouse can travel with you to Australia together with your children. If you have children that have to go to school, you will have to pay their studies that will cost you around \$8000 per year for each child. Your OSHC will cover your family as well but you will have to purchase Family Cover.

After-study options

Once becoming a fresh graduate from an Australian university, you will probably ask yourself, what are the options to stay longer in Australia?

There are many options for a person with an Australian qualification. Here are some of them:

- Skilled Independent (Subclass 189)
- Skilled Nominated (Subclass 190)
- Temporary Work (Skilled) Visa (Subclass 457)

What is Skilled Independent (Subclass 189)?

Like all skilled visas, the Skilled Independent (189) visa is a points-based application. You must be working in a job on the Skilled Occupation List (SOL) and then meet requirements around your age, English competence, training and work experience. The Skilled Independent (189) visa does not require sponsorship by a relative or state and you can live and work in any part of Australia.

Once you have activated your 189 visa, you and your family gain permanent residency in Australia. In summary, this means:

- * You and your partner to work in any job on arrival
- * You can study at an Australian school or university

- lian school or university
- * You receive subsidised healthcare through Medicare
- * You are on the pathway to Australian citizenship
- * You can sponsor others for permanent residency

What is Skilled Nominated (Subclass 190)?

Like all skilled visas, the Skilled - Nominated (190) visa is a points-based application. You must be working in a job on the Consolidated Skilled Occupation List (CSOL) and then meet requirements around your age, English competence, training and work experience.

You must also be sponsored by a state or territory. Each state has unique skill shortages and thus occupations appear at different times on different lists. Each state varies in its specific requirements. Some states require applicants to have higher English scores; others require more work experience or detailed evidence of the applicant's assets.

Once you have activated your 190 visa, you and your family gain permanent residency in Australia. In summary, this means:

- * You and your partner to work in any job on arrival
- * You can study at an Australian school or university
- * You receive subsidised

- healthcare through Medicare
- * You are on the pathway to Australian citizenship
- * You can sponsor others for permanent residency

What is 457 visa?

The Temporary Work (Skilled) visa allows skilled workers to come to Australia and work for an approved business for up to four years.

An approved business can sponsor someone for this visa if they cannot find an Australian citizen or permanent resident to do the skilled work. The nominated occupation must be on the Consolidated Skilled Occupation List (CSOL).

Employees are restricted to working only for their Sponsor and you can be in or outside Australia when you lodge your application.

To apply for 457 visa you must:


1. be nominated to work in an approved occupation on the Skilled Occupation Lists
 2. meet the skill requirements for the nominated occupation
 3. meet registration and licensing obligations
 4. speak vocational English
- be nominated by an approved business.

This visa allows you to:

1. work in Australia for up to four years
2. bring your family to work or study in Australia
3. travel in and out of Australia as often as you want.


